History

Founded by Gil Stricklin in November 2006

- Sincere Love for Railroad
- One Class 1 Railroad
- Established Dedicated Hotline for Calls
 - 1st Call Camp Point, Illinois
 - 7 More by End of Year

Had 4 Chaplains Prepared to Respond

- Trained 30 More in January 2007
- Consistently Trained Additional Chaplains Over Last 7 Years



History – Current Posture

- 109 Professionally Trained Chaplains
- Chaplains Strategically Spanned Across 26 States
- Serve Two Railroads Poised to Serve More
- □ 1st National RRC Conference
 - Scheduled for 2015

Response Procedures

Local Claims Representative Calls RRC Office Hotline

RRC Leadership Immediately...

- Gathers Information for Dissemination
- Contacts Potential RRC Chaplain for Response
- Assigns Chaplain to Incident
- Forwards All Available Information to Assigned Chaplain
- **RRC** Chaplain Immediately...
 - Confirms Assignment
 - Proceeds to Home/Hospital to Provide Care and Compassion

Long-Term Care for Up to Two Years After Incident
