California Air Update Implications for all Roads

California has led the country in environmental initiatives for the last half century, and the states Air Resources Board is pursuing new requirements that may affect the entire railroad industry, not just those that operate in the state.

Nearly 20 years after the railroads signed an historic agreement to guarantee a Tier 2 or better locomotive fleet average in California through 2030, the state is making sure no rock is left untouched to address emissions in some of the country's highest pollution areas.
